Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 Regulation 24(4) & 36, the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004

Epsom and Ewell Borough Council adopted its Core Strategy Development Plan Document (DPD) on 24 July 2007. The Core Strategy DPD forms part of the Epsom & Ewell Local Development Framework (LDF), and sets out the Council's vision, spatial strategy and overarching policies to 2022. The Core Strategy is the Council's first DPD to be adopted.

The Core Strategy, Binding Inspector's Report and this Adoption Statement are available on the Council's website www.epsom-ewell.gov.uk. Printed documents are available to view at the Town Hall and the Borough's libraries during normal opening hours.

Any person aggrieved by the Core Strategy may make an application to the High Court under section 113 of the Planning & Compulsory Purchase Act 2004, on the grounds that the document is not within the appropriate power and/ or that a procedural requirement has not been complied with. Applications must be made within six weeks of the date of adoption (i.e. by 5 September 2007).
