

# New access arrangements

On Tuesday 1 June changes will be made to the entrance of the Epsom community recycling centre and waste transfer station.

## What are the changes?

A barrier will be placed across Blenheim Road to prevent through traffic and to create two separate entrances to the waste site.

## How do I access the centre?

### I'm a resident

Residents can only access the community recycling centre from Felstead Road.

### I'm a trader

Traders and HGV drivers can only access the site via Blenheim Road, from the direction of Epsom Motor Group and Epsom Coaches. See overleaf for the road layout.

## Why has this scheme been introduced?

The scheme will reduce congestion and improve safety by separating private cars from lorries and heavy goods vehicles.

It will be monitored for a period of 12 months before any decision is made on whether to make it permanent.
