To make your views known to the Council

- You can write or speak to any local Councillor.
- You can write (either as an individual or as a signatory to a petition) to the Town Hall and ask for your views to be passed to the appropriate Committee.
- You can attend any of the meetings shown overleaf and may, at the Chairman's discretion and subject to the following arrangements, speak on matters relevant to the agenda for the meeting. All meetings normally start at 7.30pm.

General information on speaking at meetings

Details of what to do if you wish to speak at a particular committee meeting are below:

- You can find out what items are on the agenda for discussion at each of the meetings either by asking to see a copy at the Town Hall or Bourne Hall Reception area (papers are available 5 working days before the meeting), or by looking on the Council's Website (www.epsom-ewell.gov.uk).
- On planning applications, there are three categories of speaker. These are: objector, supporter and applicant/agent. If a number of people from the same category wish to speak on the same item, then that group must nominate a single speaker.
- For other Committees, if there is a large number of people wishing to speak on a particular item, speakers will normally be chosen on a first-come, first-served basis, subject to the need to allow a representative cross section of views to be heard.
- If you are invited to speak to the Committee you will be shown to a seat in the Council Chamber. The Chairman will have a list of people who wish to speak and will invite you to speak when the item is reached on the agenda. Each speaker will be allowed up to 3 minutes speaking time and a microphone will be provided so you do not need to have a loud voice. If you speak for longer than 3 minutes, or seek to raise matters not relevant to the agenda, you may be stopped by the Committee Chairman and asked to return to your seat.
- If you attend a committee meeting, a number of copies of the agenda and other papers will be available on the night, free of charge.
- People who are speaking at a meeting should meet in the reception area before the meeting starts and they will be directed to the Chamber or Committee room.
- Any members of the public who have difficulty accessing the public gallery, may sit at the rear of the Chamber. Please ask at reception before the meeting starts for assistance to the lifts.

Licensing matters are dealt with by a separate Committee, representations at which are subject to statutory regulations which will be explained on request.
