Hack Riding



There are extensive hack areas and rides marked on the map overleaf. In addition there is access along several roads and public bridleways. Use of some of the hack areas and rides is restricted until noon to reduce conflict with racehorse training. Hack areas and rides are marked by posts with blue arrows (allowing riding at any time), red crosses (no hack riding) and yellow arrows (riding allowed after noon). (Map on reverse)

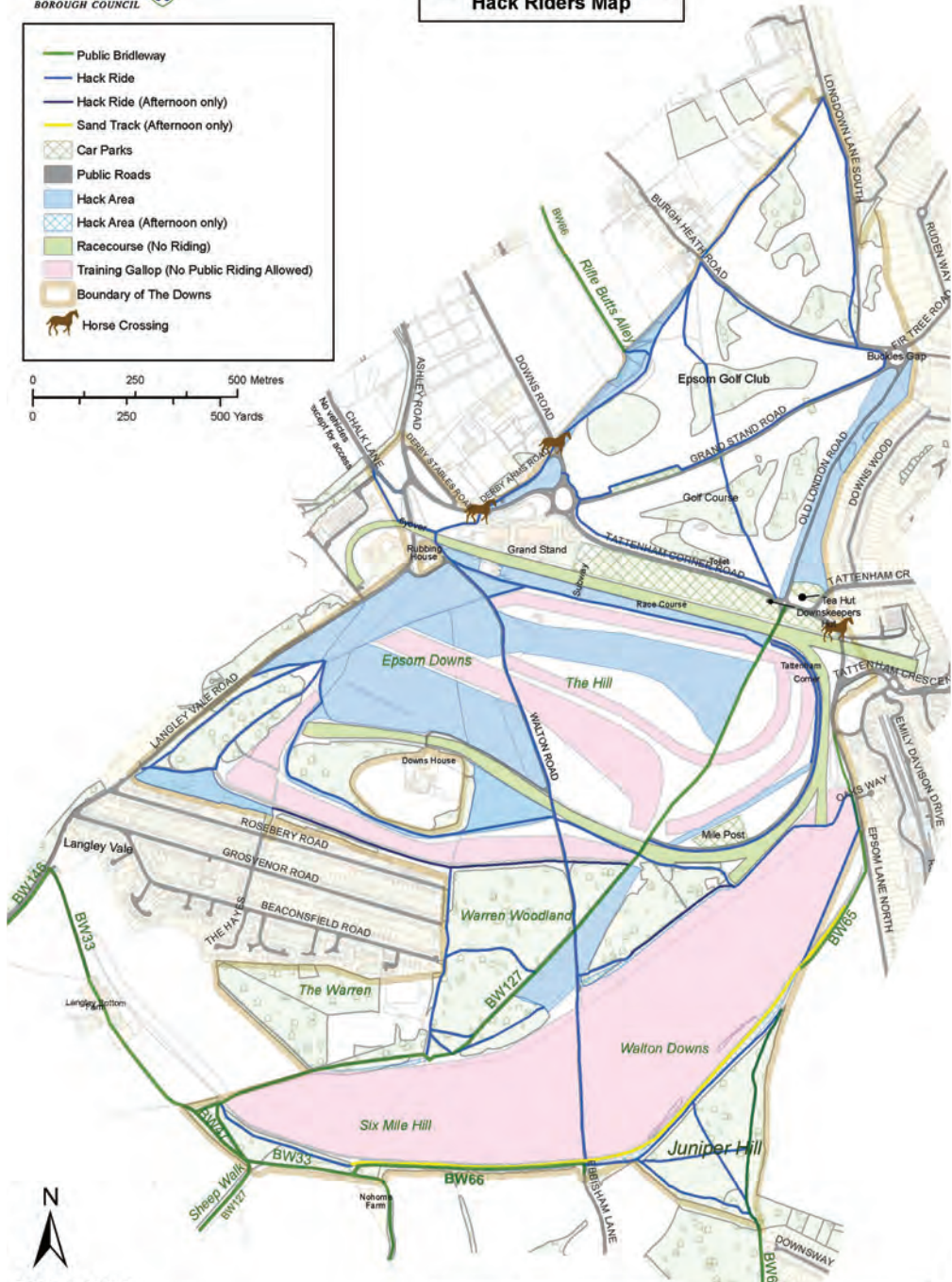
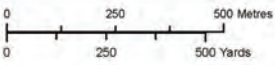
