The Register now appears in two forms - Full or Edited.

The Full Register of Electors has the names and addresses of everyone registered to vote and is updated every month. Anyone can look at it, but copies can only be supplied for certain purposes, such as elections and law enforcement. Credit reference agencies are also allowed to use the full register, but only to check names and addresses of those applying for credit and to help stop money laundering. Anyone who has a copy of the full register will be committing a criminal offence if they unlawfully pass on information from it.
