<p>Cyrenians Hostel 18 Walnut Tree Close, Guildford, Surrey 01483 560762</p>	<p>Cyrenians offers short term supported housing for men over the age of 18. They have 11 beds which are accessible by referral from a professional agency only. They will receive telephone enquiries between 9am - 6pm.</p>
<p>Step by Step 8 Arthur Street, Aldershot, Hampshire 01252 329825.</p>	<p>Step by Step (Emmaus House) has 11 beds, providing 13 week placements for 16-25 year olds. They are able to provide support and assistance with securing permanent accommodation. Provided that the client is eligible, the placements are funded by Housing Benefit with the client paying a contribution of £12.00 per week (£7.00 of this is a food charge, £5.00 is a residents charge.) There is a waiting list of approximately two weeks but this can vary according to demand. Where possible, Emmaus House aims to accommodate both men and women. Clients can refer themselves or be referred by another agency. Phones will not be staffed between midnight and 8am. Emmaus House also has one 'night stop' bed for use in emergency situations. The charge for this room is £25.00 per night, payable by the client.</p>
