Pitched slate roof. Coped gable end on kneelers. One storey. L-shaped plan. South wing has triple lancet with glazing bars with plain chamfered surrounds. East wing has single lancet with oblong flanking lights, surmounted by copied gable on kneelers. One storey extension to east with hipped roof and oblong window. Buttress and porch on west side</i>

Single 1st floor casement with glazing bars, projecting on covedoriel. Ground floor has 2 side wings, with double curved ramping parapets.Moulded cornice over continuous plain fascia, taken on pilasters withgreen glazed tile panels in brown borders. Between pilasters are, alternately,3 doors with oblong fanlights, and 2 plate glass windows over green glazedtile panels with brown borders. Garage doors in left hand wing.</i>
