The Specsavers Surrey Youth Games is the largest competition for young people in Surrey.

Young people aged 7-16 can take part in a range of sports with the chance to represent their borough and take on the 10 other boroughs and districts in the county. It's a great opportunity to try a new sport and improve your skills whilst receiving top level coaching... for free!

The training sessions are led by local sports clubs. Each club offers participants the chance to continue playing their chosen sport after the Games have finished. The 2017 Specsavers Surrey Youth Games will take place on 17-18 June at the Surrey Sports Park in Guildford. Training sessions will take place from April.

To be eligible to represent Team Epsom & Ewell participants must live or go to school in the borough and be of sub-county standard in their chosen sport.

Take a look at the list of sports and decide which ones you want to try!

You must register online to be eligible to take part in the training sessions and represent Team Epsom & Ewell. Registrations for some sports may close early if the entries are high. Please register at your earliest convenience to avoid disappointment.
