



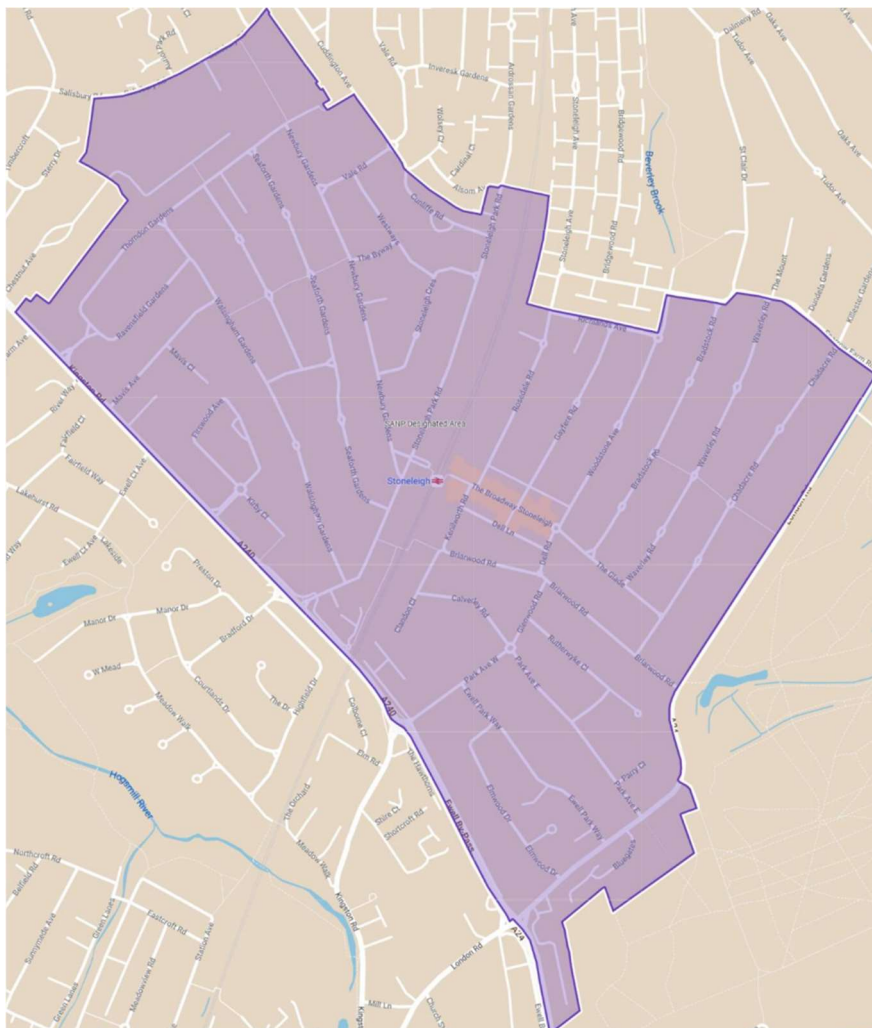
Stoneleigh and Auriol Neighbourhood Plan Area Referendum Information Statement

A Referendum relating to the adoption of the Stoneleigh and Auriol Neighbourhood Plan will be on the **12 February 2026**.

The question which will be asked in the Referendum is:

**“Do you want Epsom and Ewell Borough Council to use the
Neighbourhood Plan for the Stoneleigh and Auriol neighbourhood area
to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area.”**

The Referendum area is shown on the below map.



It is identical to the area which has previously been designated as the Stoneleigh and Auriol Neighbourhood Designation Area, 12 November 2020.

A person is entitled to vote in the Referendum on 12 February 2026 if:

- They are entitled to vote in a local government election in the Referendum area; and
- Their qualifying address for the election is in the Referendum area.

A person's qualifying address is, in relation to a person registered in the register of electors, the address in respect of which he or she is entitled to be registered.

The Referendum expenses limit that will apply in relation to the Referendum is £2,758.01. The number of persons entitled to vote in the Referendum by reference to which that limit has been calculated is 6,712.

The Referendum will be conducted in accordance with procedures which are similar to those used at local government elections.
