History

In the early Middle Ages the Hogsmill was a powerful stream that turned several mills. By 1408 there were only two, the Upper and Lower Mills (although Ruxley and Ewell Court had their own). Both were used as corn mills, however, for several years, the Lower Mill was also used as a paper mill.

Sadly the Lower Mill burnt down in 1938, whilst the Upper Mill continued production until 1953.
