

Absent votes at election time

There are set deadlines for postal and proxy vote applications at Election time.

Proxy Votes

If you want to appoint a proxy that application must be made by

no later than **5pm**, 6 working days before polling day.

Postal vote application forms can be obtained from Electoral Services at the Town Hall, The Parade, Epsom, Surrey KT18 5BY or forms can be downloaded from our website at – www.epsom-ewell.gov.uk

Postal Votes – New applications, amendments or cancellations of existing postal votes and proxy amendments or cancellations must be received

no later than **5pm**, 11 working days before polling day.

We normally send out postal votes by 1st Class post from 2 days after the closing date for a particular election. If we are able to send them out earlier we will do so but it depends entirely on the election being held. More information regarding actual posting dates will be available closer to the date of an election.

If you are going to be away around the issue date for postal votes you may prefer to appoint a proxy to vote on your behalf instead.
