Note:

* As from May 2023 there are now 14 wards with a mix of two and three seats.

^ The Parliamentary constituency is changing and will consist of the whole of EEBC & the Ashted & Leatherhead wards from Mole Valley DC. The wards previously included from Reigate & Banstead will no longer vote in the Epsom & Ewell constituency.

^^ After the 2010 Parliamentary election the Government announced changes to legislation and brought in fixed terms for Parliamentary elections although the Government can call an election at any time.

^^^ In 2022 new legislation was brought in to repeal the Fixed Term Parliaments Act 2011 and this now allows the Prime Minister to call a general election at a time of their choosing.

** This Police & Crime Commissioner election was postponed from 7 May 2020 however the 4 year rule applies so the next election will be in 2024
