<b>2</b>	<b>Student nurses</b>
<b>3</b>	<b>Apprentices</b>
<b>4</b>	<b>Youth training trainees</b>
<b>5</b>	<b>Patients in hospital</b>
<b>6</b>	<b>People who are being looked after in residential care homes (such as hospices), mental nursing homes and hostels providing a high level of care</b>
<b>8</b>	<b>People kept in hospital under the Mental Health Act 1983</b>
<b>9</b>	<b>People staying in certain hostels or night shelters (such as the Salvation Army)</b>
<b>10</b>	<b>Monks and nuns</b>
<b>11</b>	<b>Care workers working on low pay and usually for charities, such as Community Service Volunteers; people caring for someone with a disability who is not a spouse, partner or child under 18</b>
<b>12</b>	<b>Convicted or remand prisoners, except people in prison for non-payment of fines and/or Council Tax</b>
<b>13</b>	<b>Diplomats, members of visiting forces and certain international institutions</b>
<b>14</b>	<b>Non-British spouse of a student</b>
