Epsom & Ewell Borough Council Submission Local Plan 2022-2040.

Epsom & Ewell Borough Council is pleased to submit the Proposed Submission Local Plan 2022-2040, for independent examination in accordance with Regulation 22 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended). Appendix 1 to this letter includes a list of documents that have been submitted, these documents have been submitted to the Planning Inspectorate will soon be available on Local Plan examination web page: https://www.epsom-ewell.gov.uk/localplanexamination

A hard copy of the Local Plan and Policies Map has been sent to our programme officer to be made available to the appointed Inspector in due course.

The Local Plan making process commenced in 2022, with consultation on the draft Plan under Regulation 18 during February and March 2023. More recently, consultation under Regulation 19 was undertaken from 20 December 2024 until 5 February 2025. The Plan includes a comprehensive vision for the Borough up to 2040, nine strategic objectives, both strategic and development management policies and thirty-five site allocations.

Authority to submit the Local Plan for examination was agreed at the Councils' meeting on 10 December 2024.

National Planning Policy Framework

The Local Plan is being submitted under the transitional arrangements in Annex 1 of the December 2024 version of the National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF). Annex 1, para 234 allows for Local Plans to be submitted on or before 12 March 2025 to be examined under the earlier version of the Framework.

Duty to Co-operate

Throughout the preparation of the Local Plan officers have worked collaboratively with a range of statutory agencies and neighbouring local planning authorities. Consequently a Duty-to-Co-operate Statement of Compliance has been produced, supported by seven Statements of Common Ground. Please note that at the time of submission we are

awaiting a signed statement of common ground with National Highways. We anticipate that this will be completed by the end of March 2025.

Proposed Modifications

In accordance with section 20(7C) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as amended), the Council requests that the Inspector recommends main modifications as necessary to make the plan sound and legally compliant.

Delegated Authority has been given to the Head of Place Development in consultation with the Chair of Licensing and Planning Policy Committee to prepare modifications as necessary.
