Green recycling bin

Collected every week

Yes please

- paper and cardboard
- cans, tins, aerosols, metal bottle tops and caps, metal jar lids
- cartons, such as drinks and soup cartons
- plastics, such as plastic bottles, tubs, trays, pots, blister packs
- please put textiles, clothes, shoes and accessories in a sealed, clearly labelled bag by the side of your bin



No glass/no food Glass goes in your kerbside box so it can't smash and damage other recycling. Put food in your caddy
