

In order to avoid conflict with other users, particularly horseriders, the area for flying kites is restricted under the Byelaws to that part of the Downs enclosed by the Old London Road to the north, east and south and to the west by Public Bridleway 127. (Shown on map overleaf).

Kite Flying should not be undertaken before noon daily in this area of the Downs which is regularly used by racehorses as this activity causes distress to the horses.

Anyone breaking this requirement is liable to a prosecution under the Downs Byelaws which state that it is an offence to give reasonable cause for annoyance to any other person in the proper use of the Downs.

fter noon there are no race horses being trained but care should be taken to avoid annoyance to hack riders using the Downs.
